Letter of Commitment to the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact

as an international network of family-owned businesses, we are eager to fulfil the expectations of our shareholders, members, employees, customers and the society to manage our business responsibly. Therefore, I am pleased to confirm that INPACS supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on Human Rights, Labour, Environment and Anti-Corruption.

With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles. We are committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.
